Coming to Terms with E-Smog

Electro-smog is something that we have found really upsets the function of the HBF. If you were able to get to the conference in Spain you will already know a little about it. Some new observations have been made about this, and I thought it would be a good idea to tell you about it.

First of all, we are not overly concerned about where it comes from and what causes it, because this is political and therefore an endless rabbit warren that we have not time to go down. It stretches from the very low frequency radiation from power lines right up to micro wave and beyond. In the opinion of some this forms a sort of continuum of radiation that is complex in nature because fields are able to intersect and interact with each other once they meet with the HBF. The HBF seems to work like an electronic mixer, in other words.

The most sensitive organ to all this electro-smog is the Spleen, and that is why the newly released Spleen Omentum Driver is so important in the treatment of E-smog clients.

Spleen Omentum Driver is likely to have quite an immediate effect on the side effects of E-smog, and by this I mean in about 10 minutes. Several people have remarked to me on the almost immediate improvement in their breathing after taking Spleen Omentum Driver. Of course the Spleen Omentum is in another body cavity! It looks as though there is more going on than we thought with Spleen Omentum Driver.

My own experience is interesting, at least for me. Every time I went to visit a local town, my breathing went bad again, and every time I returned home, about 15 kilometers from the city, my breathing was as if I had asthma, very poor indeed. Ten minutes after taking Infoceuticals the problem

cleared. I repeated this day after day and came to the conclusion that the local town was a source of really bad electro-smog. It was, as my Spanish gets a little better I read in the local paper that there are no less than 20 phone transmitters all on one roof in the town and that their emissions are not within the allowed limits.

As I have said, it is not a good idea to take Spleen Omentum driver for too long as the emotions belonging to that Compartment begin to come out to the surface. So for E-smog it is necessary to change to ES-1, which is better tolerated for longer periods.

Taking Spleen Omentum Driver together with ES -1 has a dramatic effect on two major sections of the immune system of your body. Naturally this will take some time to become apparent, because of the time it takes for immune cells to mature in the body.

We have a framework that allows us to understand E-smog fairly well, whereas others may not be able to fit it into their paradigm. We are able to understand that E-smog affects the Spleen as well as the Heart as well as the function of the immunity.

The unexplained failure of the immune system in the case of Asthma, Chronic Fatigue, MS, and even HIV and cancer suddenly comes to our attention. I am not the first person to suggest that CFS is linked with E-smog.

We have reports that people with E-smog difficulties experience heart palpitations, when they get exposure as well as when they take Infoceuticals. If you don't have heart disease, then heart palpitations are not really a big problem. It is a harmless effect which soon goes away.

There is really nothing else that I know of available which will help with electro-sensitivity, other than our two new Infoceuticals. In my own case I found

that it took more than three weeks of solid dosing with ES-1 to correct the problem. The result is that now I can walk up hills without losing my breath after about 50 paces.

So again, I remind you that we never like to claim formulas for specific diseases – and why is this? Because we know so little of the mechanism of diseases that we think it is better to concentrate on health and forget about the “names” of the diseases. In the case of asthma for example, the traditional Chinese system recognises more than 20 different syndromes of laboured breathing. Even Western medicine has come to the conclusion that it may not be the same disease, just something going wrong with the same result.

One of the side effects of correcting the E-smog I was suffering from was a dramatic increase in concentration span, from that of a fruit fly, to something a bit better. Others have reported this effect to me as well so it is well worth recording.

Now you ask how long does the treatment “hold” for? Will you be taking little bottles of drops until you move to a tent in the Sahara? No, not really. It takes three to four weeks to correct, using big doses, then you may need occasional small doses after you have had a massive exposure to E-smog, for example after flying, or after going near phone towers, or massive long term exposure to computers.

I have already said that I think if you breathe in heavy metals, as most people have done from the residues of petrol, or gas as I think the Americans say, then you will also need to get rid of that, particularly if you are sensitive to E-smog. This means you need to look to see if ES-15 comes up on the NES screen. This takes many months to do, as these residues get into the fats, the blood, as well as the bones.

The NES scan will give you a hint about E-smog sensitivity. You must look at the Spleen Omentum Driver and the Heart Driver, as well of course at the immunity function represented by Immunity driver and ES-1. Then you must ask your client about pains in the heart, palpitations, and breathing difficulty, concentration span and so on.

Many years ago, when I was just starting the long journey towards getting a new system going, I wondered about hearing loss. This was because of a family predisposition towards nerve deafness. I found that the inner ear is a perfect place for Energetic Terrains, and in fact I found the first ET's in the inner ear, way back in 1984. Why do I mention this now? Because E-smog is linked to the Energetic Terrains! You get the immune system to work far better when you treat for E-smog. So one of the possible side effects is change to your hearing acuity, as the terrains in the inner ear change for the better.

I have experienced huge increases in hearing acuity, just for short periods. Like a few minutes. This would not be possible if the ear was really permanently damaged would it! This means that it may be possible, one day, to improve nerve deafness... but that's another story for much later on in our development.

When you treat E-smog the immunity slowly gets better, and this is good. Your client may not agree, since there may be pains in the tonsils, ears, teeth, eyes and so on as the Terrains are cleared up.

That gives you some of the ideas about E-smog we were talking about at the Conference. I am sure you will have some great healing stories to tell very soon!

NES Conference in Denia 2007

What was it that drew me to go to the NES conference in Denia this year? Accessibility was one thing, being the first time it has been held in Europe. Some warm spring sunshine in April and the opportunity to mix with other NES practitioners were also important. Then there were the tantalising morsels offered to tempt one to go. Presentations by Peter Fraser and Harry Massey on NES in its current form, its recent additions and where it's heading in the future. Also talks from practitioners who have had considerable success with NES offering insight into the way they worked. Rumours of a Spanish doctor presenting a piece on anti-aging, VERY interesting for those of us beyond the first flush of youth – oh, and of course for our patients!

I am a registered homeopath with over 10 years experience. I am also a reflexologist, work with hot stones and am currently training in craniosacral therapy. I bought NES 2 years ago and added it into my practice, using it either instead of or after initial homeopathic treatment. I had got to the stage where I didn't feel I was using NES enough, it was getting sidelined in my practice although I felt it had enormous potential.

When I looked at why this was happening, I felt it was to do with the depth of my understanding of the energetic changes taking place in the body/mind when remedies or infoceuticals were given. This was obviously greater with homeopathy than NES due to more experience. I had tried doing some extra study on NES at home, but had found that to be slow-going. I needed to be re-inspired about NES and I thought the conference was the way to do that.



I arrived late on Thursday evening at the Marriot, the conference venue. It was a very nice hotel and there in the reception area were some of the NES team, Helen, Diane, Kelvin and Steve waiting to greet me and supply me with my conference pack.

I had a lovely room, large, attractive and comfortable and a balcony with table and chairs. I later discovered that mine caught the early evening sunshine – very pleasant after a day's lectures.

The next morning it was up early and, after breakfast – the breakfast buffet was spectacular – it was downstairs to the conference area. This consisted of a good-sized lecture room adjoining a large area for tea and coffee breaks which had big glass doors leading out to the pool area. Perfect for catching a breath of air and the occasional sunbeam in breaks. Unfortunately the lectures and presentations started at 9 o'clock...!! I was not the only one that felt that was too early and I think that there would be a later start in future years.

On entering the conference room one could see on the tables, along with the usual water, someone had thoughtfully provided a bottle of Polarity and Source Driver each for everyone to help clear out any effects of the air travel and keep our energy levels well-resourced. It even helped get rid of a residue of jet lag I had from the week before.

The three days that followed were a good balance of information transfer from the speakers, matching and sharing with other practitioners and, of course, socialising – just for fun!

Harry Massey opened the conference with an update on current developments and a look ahead to what's coming. There is a new and improved Liver Driver and an updated ES1 which addresses the growing issue of E-smog (Peter later named ES 1 as his Desert Island infoceutical). There is also a brand new Spleen Driver to replace Thymus driver (more about that later). He spoke about the software, the new NES 4 is designed in a modular way, making it much easier to update. The next stage is a 3-D version, which shouldn't be too far away, allowing a view inside the body and eventually showing detail right down to each tendon and ligament. Further ahead, there are plans to develop a hand-held device for treating musculo-skeletal issues which appear on the screen. I found this all very exciting.

Several practitioners who have had widespread success with NES talked in detail about how they used it. Randi Eaton said that she had indifferent early results with the odd fantastic one and felt she wasn't using NES to its full potential as she wasn't proficient enough. I felt some echoes (or matching, perhaps) of my own experience and was interested when she talked about how she addressed that. She looked at her whole belief system around NES and her practice and realised that she needed to sell health, not illness. She looked around at her consulting room and waiting room. Several items bit the dust such as information posters about illness. She found it also mattered when and how she took the reading, maximising the modalities of the condition, so as to get a clear, focused snapshot of the nature of the disturbance of the HBF.

She also echoed the emotional aspect, something that also came through very strongly in Lorraine Whitby's presentation. If the client can access it, being strongly in the emotional state which comes with the condition whilst taking the reading, helps sharpen the picture and highlight what needs to be done first.

Jason Siczkowycz also talked through his practice with NES which he and his brother use 99% of the time. He talked about initial treatment with base protocol and how further down the line you're looking for patterns within the results. He commented on the fact that it's not always easy to correlate results with symptoms, something I have sometimes found in the past. In my case, I've always felt that this could be remedied by understanding the Integrators and how they

interact better and how the other infoceuticals fit in around them. What NES can do, even without that, is show the path through to the root of the problem as symptoms don't always correlate in an obvious way to the disturbance in the HBF.

Dr Miguel mentioned this in one of his talks. He talked about certain organs being out of rhythm with the system and borrowing energy from other organs. For example a patient may present with heart symptoms, but it's the pancreas that's really out of sync, borrowing energy from the heart, so the root problem is in the pancreas. As he said, NES tells him which systems are out of rhythm with the rest, whatever the symptoms. And as Jason said, imagine how many tests he would have to do to find out if someone's headaches were structural, vascular, based in the nervous system, emotional or caused by allergies.

This idea of some parts and energy patterns borrowing energy from others as they are underpowered was also mentioned by Peter in one of his presentations. On the subject of Peter, I'm very glad we have full transcripts of his major speeches as the information was so richly packed, that even good note-taking was not sufficient.

Peter, in his lectures on The Coming Medical Revolution, tracked some of the journey from the current reductionist theories to the recognition that energy comes before the material and that material is an expression of energy. He talked about mitochondria, those little powerhouses in all cells. Biologists have believed that mitochondria are powered by the breakdown of carbohydrates and sugar, but testing with NES has been unable to "match" them energetically with those substances or with ATP. What does "match" is Source Driver, believed to be Zero Point Energy gathered in the cavities in the body and concentrated and amplified.

He also talked about the failure of the Human Genome project to identify enough separate genes to make gene therapy the new wonder-tool of reductionist medicine. The news that we have about the same number of genes as an earthworm means that genes are not the driving force of life. So genetics are not responsible for all pathology and there is not one gene per illness which can be tweaked to cure. Peter's studies indicate that all genetic material lives EI 10 so that it might account for about one twelfth of pathology – which about reflects the results of gene therapy. And on the advances in modern medicine, he then came up with the startling fact that a US resident was more likely to die of cancer now (figures from 1999) than in 1950.

Another of Peter's lectures was to tell us about the new Spleen/Omentum Driver. Often people require this if they have had abdominal surgery. It also has a marked effect on the chest.

The spleen in Chinese medicine is thought to hold deeply suppressed anger and bitterness and so sometimes when taking it, it can make you grumpy, or, as Peter so memorably put it "bring out your inner bitch".

I enjoyed his lecture on Integrators and am looking forward to watching the DVD I bought with lectures on Drivers, Integrators, Terrains and Stars. Although I love the written word, a good lecture brings the whole thing to life.

And what of Dr Miguel and his lecture on anti-aging? Suffice it to say that I am pedalling back through the years at a rate of knots. If I'm not careful, I'll be back at school again. No really, though, it was a very interesting lecture. Dr Miguel treats many sports people who are looking for optimum health and performance. He feels that it's perfect to work with NES even when there is no pathology. He uses NES with other approaches to develop superior health in individuals. He uses both base protocol, altered dosage and some set protocols for more vitality, anti-oxidant effect, mental acuity and skin aging.

Bruce gave us a talk on Understanding the Human Body Field. It seems that the vibration of atoms has both an in-wave and an out-wave. These waves are not linear, but spherical. Where the in- and out-wave meet forms a spherical standing wave. (You could mock up a spherical standing wave by throwing a stone into a tank full of water and watching the ripples spread out from the point of impact, bounce off the side of the tank and return. Where they meet on their inward and outward journey forms the standing wave, apparently still, but vibrating in both directions) The ripples of atoms are formed

not by throwing stones into a water tank, but from changes in the density of space. Each atom has its own spherical standing wave and it is the interference pattern of these waves which form the holographic Human Body Field.



Joan Wilcox gave a fascinating talk on the latest scientific research. She is gathering together many pieces of research such as this one from the Heartmath Institute. This experiment wired subjects up to both EKG's and ECG's to measure brain and heart waves. The subjects were shown a series of pictures, most of which were benign, but with the occasional unpleasant one which would create anxiety. As they were being shown the pictures, 3.5 seconds BEFORE the unpleasant one was shown, the brain registered anxiety. So the brain picked up the emotional resonance of a future event 3.5 seconds before it happened. When they looked at the heart waves, they had picked up the resonance 4.8 seconds before the event. So the heart knew BEFORE the brain.

She told us about some conventional medical research showing that the heart has a nervous system and a much larger electrical field than the brain and so much more! Her talk didn't seem long enough and we'd all have loved to have heard more. She is setting up a website for bioenergetic research and has said if any of us come across anything interesting in this field, could we please email her at .

Obviously I enjoyed the lectures, but I also enjoyed the other aspects of the conference. Mixing with other practitioners and the speakers in the breaks, talking about what we had heard and how we might use this new knowledge or insight in our practices. There was an exchange of extra little snippets of information and email addresses. We were from many disparate countries and therapeutic backgrounds, but came together as a group to exchange and learn together. It was great also that there was a strong turn-out from NES in Poole. Simon, Kelvin, Helen, Diane, Bruce, Steve and Paul were all around to help with anything from questions about the new software to what time your transfer was booked to the airport. They did a great job and kept the whole thing running smoothly.

So, during the day we were kept well-occupied with lectures, discussions and delicious buffet lunches but what about the evenings? On the first night, Harry and Peter hosted a cocktail party out in the pool area. There was a minor fancy dress theme and some people did dress up a little or a lot with the notable exception of Harry and Peter. I'm not a big fan of fancy dress myself so I was glad it was just a suggestion. The party was fun, however, and afterwards a large group of us took taxis down to a local restaurant where they had great fish.

Disease is the result of Big Body Wave Distortion

Following the Conference in Denia, Spain, I followed up some comments I made on morphology... the shape of the big body field in space. Then I received a letter from Randi Eaton in USA, asking about Diabetes treatments and the apparent difficulty in finding a single approach.

In Chinese Medicine there are 20 or more types of asthma. It is not a disease in itself but the result of multiple errors in the body energy system. You can also apply this thinking as well to Diabetes Mellitus. It is not a single disease but the result of multiple errors in the body field. So we cannot really give you a formula.

There are many things that will help Diabetes in our system, but you need not rely upon chance. The NES scan is of help here, as you may be able to find parts of clues in the scan that will enable you to make a reasonably clever treatment.

The first thing to do is to look on your screen, not so much for Pancreas Driver, but for Bone Driver, EI 3+6+9, as well as Heart Driver. What? Have I gone mad? No, not really. I have already said that it is not really ever a good idea to treat a sick organ and that is because the organ might not be the cause of the disease at all. We have to go deeper than that to heal. People ring us up and tell us Pancreas Driver does not come up on the NES screen when there is Diabetes. We KNOW!

EI -12, EI-3, EI-6 and EI-9 all represent the axes of the body wave and when there is distortion these axes, the 90 degree ones, take the weight if you like. If these are showing up in tests, here is an approach.

First Treatment;

Bone Driver EI-3 EI-6

These are taken in order at one treatment session, and the dose should be low at first. NO longer than a week of this.

Later Treatment;

Heart Driver EI-3 EI-6 EI-9

These are taken in order at one treatment session, and the dose should be very low and not too often. This is a very strong correction to the whole of the body field at once. It is not for beginners who have not done the NES courses.

These are not formulas for Diabetes. There isn't one! They are suggested ways of making big corrections to the way the body is shaped by its field.



Practitioner Profile:

This month, Kelvin Snaith, Practitioner Support Manager for Nutri-Energetics Systems, interviewed Dylan Warren-Davis, MNIMH, a medical herbalist and NES Practitioner.

Dylan has been involved with herbal medicine for over 30 years. He is currently practicing herbal medicine at a clinic in Llandeilo with his wife and fellow medical herbalist Stella Anderson, BSc, MNIMH.

Since qualifying as a prize winning student with the National Institute of Medical Herbalists in 1982, Dylan has been involved in further research rediscovering the lost European metaphysical teachings, upon which western herbal knowledge is based.

He is the author of two books (both available on Amazon); 'Astrology and Health' and 'The Hand Reveals', and has had several articles published over the years.

Kelvin (K): Dylan, thanks for agreeing to speak to me, I really appreciate it. I will get straight into the questions;

How long have you been using the NES system in your clinic?

Dylan (D): We got it at about the end of July last year. As soon as it arrived, we loaded it up and went straight into a full day's practice of about 15 clients. Stella was seeing the herbal clients and I was using the NES device. We did it in stereo and took off from there.

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K: Is it just the two of you in the clinic?

D: Yes. We both had experience of multi-disciplinary clinics and the politics of them just gets you down eventually, so in getting our new clinic together here in Llandeilo, that's the one thing we've successfully avoided!

K: Can you tell me a little more about what you were doing before being introduced to NES?

D: Mainly using Herbs and Nutrition. Stella is also an iridologist so she was additionally using the eyes to diagnose. I was just doing a regular case history and tuning into people as best as I could with the various skills that I have learnt over the years. The astrology and hand reading in terms of my clinical work, are no longer part of it. They were once upon a time when I was practicing in London, 10 years ago, however, since 9/11 people have become more sceptical of using that knowledge within the clinical context. There was a time when I could drive quite a good income from practicing these disciplines but since then it has really died a death! As a consequence I have been diagnostically frustrated – that is until NES came along!
